
Debris Digging Rake XL with Stoneguard Assembly Instructions




Install a 3/8" x 3.5" hex bolt through a 3/8" washer, through a ½" washer, through a spring, through the steel tube, through a 3/8" washer and finally install a 3/8" nyloc nut. Tighten firmly. Repeat for all springs.






Insert the 2x Adjustment Frames into the Frame, and begin turning the Jack Handle until thread catches and draws them in. Keep turning handle until frames are at top position.




Progress so far.




Set the magnetic sweeper you will be installing the Debris Digging Rake onto, up on wooden blocks and remove the tongue.

Note: this process is easiest with 3 people. One person handling the tongue, and two others handling the rake attachment (one person on each side of it)




Slide the Debris Digging Rake over the tongue as shown.

Note: this process is easiest with 3 people. One person handling the tongue, and two others handing the rake attachment (one person on each side of it)




Re-install the tongue and the bent pin with clip.

Note: this process is easiest with 3 people. One person handling the tongue, and two others handing the rake attachment (one person on each side of it)



- Push Rake assembly backwards on the tongue as far as you can until it touches the sweeper.
- tighten the 1/2" bolt firmly



- remove wooden blocks
